

Who is the North Hills Genealogists?

North Hills Genealogists is a group of people interested in genealogy and in discovering their family history. Located in the North Hills of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, our members have a common interest in the areas north of the city, or live there.

We preserve the history of the North Hills through books we have published:

1. *Pioneer Cemeteries of Hampton Township* is out of print.
2. *Pioneer Cemeteries of Pine & Richland Townships* is available for \$39.95 (\$29.95 for members).
3. *Pioneer Cemeteries of Franklin Park Borough & Marshall Township* sells for \$29.95 (\$22.95 for members).
Pennsylvania residents add 7% sales tax. Libraries may use member pricing.

Each hardbound, library-quality book includes complete readings for older or abandoned cemeteries and is augmented with previous readings, church records, and caretaker's records when available. Each stone is recorded exactly with dates, relationships, epitaphs, stonecarvers' names, and a description of the stone. An everyname index includes maiden names, funeral directors, and military units. Many photos, histories of the area, and maps are included.

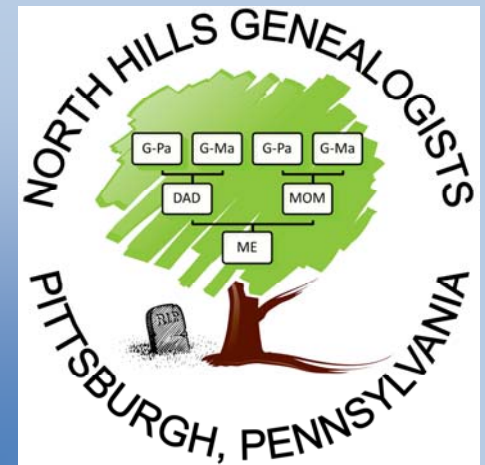

Meeting Our Mission Goals

At our monthly meeting we have a guest speaker address the group on a subject related to genealogy. We also regularly schedule a "roundtable discussion," which allows all attendees to ask a question or share a research find. A "freebie" table of interesting genealogical pamphlets may also be available.

We publish ten newsletters per year (no July or December issues) which are indexed in the Periodical Source Index (PERSI). You will find helpful articles about the latest resources and websites, tips on how to do better genealogy, announcements of upcoming genealogical events, and research queries. This membership benefit is \$15 per year (August to July).

The purposes of the organization are:

1. To provide instruction and education for its members and the general public in accepted methods of genealogy,
2. To develop family researchers through the encouragement of beginners,
3. To promote the preservation of genealogical records and resources of the North Hills of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and,
4. To support the genealogical interests of the Northland Public Library.

Donations are often made to Northland Public Library to support their genealogical collection. We also are co-sponsors of library "lock-ins" in which member volunteers help attendees with their family histories.

Preserving North Hills History

We preserve history with projects such as compiling and publishing cemetery records. NHG has published three books: *Pioneer Cemeteries of Hampton Township, Allegheny County, PA* (200 pp., 1997), *Pioneer Cemeteries of Pine and Richland Townships, Allegheny County, PA* (496 pp., 2003) and *Pioneer Cemeteries of Franklin Park Borough and Marshall Township* (368 pp., 2007). The everyname indexes from the three books are available on our website.

Meetings are Open to All

We meet the third Tuesday of every month, except December, starting at 7 P.M. at the Northland Public Library, 300 Cumberland Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15237-5455. All meetings are free and open to the public. "Tip Time" at 6:45 PM allows you to ask questions to be answered by other attendees or by an expert.
